IDA Matched Savings Program Launched January 2019



The Individual Development Account (IDA) program is designed to assist families in the purchase of affordable housing. Homebuyers will be able to use the IDA funds towards closing costs and/or down payment assistance for the purchase of a home.

- Eligible participants receive 4:1 matched savings
- Save a minimum of \$500 and a maximum of \$1,000
- Funds available for one year from completion of the program towards home purchase
